O LORD our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!


## **READING: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13**

#### **SERMON**

#### THANKSGIVING FOR BAPTISM

Joined to Christ in the waters of baptism, saturated with God's grace and forgiveness, let us give thanks.

Creator God, fountain of living water, your love flows through water, sustaining life in all communities, nourishing and delighting all creatures of the earth.

We give thanks for your gift of water.
Water that has been around since life began,
when the Spirit hovered over the face of the deep.
Water that Christ was baptized into,
reconciling all of creation into you—Holy God Triune.

For water and Word at our baptisms, and for water and Word at Caleigh, Dylan, and Eli's baptism.

We give thanks for water that floats in the sky, where clouds embrace wind, sunlight, and the pull of gravity. We give thanks for water that saturates all the earth, down to intricate places like the midnight zone of the ocean, where bioluminescent life thrives in the darkness.

For your promises show up in the most intricate of places, in water that forms rainbows and carves rocks. For you, O Creator are in the midst of all things.

As we confirm and affirm faith bound to our baptismal water and Word, we ask that you continue to guide us, and nourish us with your life-giving water that gushes up to eternal life.

Shower us with your Holy Spirit, drench us in your love, and immerse us with your grace. Amen.

#### AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM



Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us.


#### **LORD'S PRAYER**
